

## Vaccinated Students Getting Ready and Travelling to Canada:

First Stop in Canada - Vancouver

Before Departing for Canada Connect with your Delta School District homestay family (if applicable) Join a Delta School District
International Programs Pre-Departure
Zoom Call with your parents

Print out all documents you will need to bring with you on the airplane, including your vaccination records in English or French Bring Study Permit documentation with you if you applied for one



Make sure you have all documents organized and accessible

Even vaccinated travellers must have a quarantine plan in place. Complete the ArriveCAN App. See our walkthrough instructions handout for assistance

Receive a PCR test no more than 72 hours before your final departure to Canada



Text / WhatsApp your homestay family so they know you have landed (if applicable) Go through immigration with all your papers organized and prepared to show if requested. Understand the quarantine exemption is at the discretion of the CBSA officer

Text / WhatsApp your homestay family that you are now waiting for your luggage (waiting for luggage and Study Permit for new students)

Collect your luggage and (for new students) get your Study Permit. Put Study Permit away safely

Maintain a list of all close contacts for your first 14 days in Canada Give the instructions
you should have
received at
Immigration to your
host family (if applicable)

Leave the airport and connect with your homestay family (if applicable) Be prepared that you may be randomly selected to undergo an Arrival Covid-19 test If you have any issues with your Study Permit, WhatsApp Ms. Karen
